- First, read through the power point doing any tasks as you go.
- Next, read pages 1-6 of the booklet this explains what you need to do and the techniques you are looking for e.g. layout, emotive language and other persuasive techniques.
- Next, look at the practice, completed analysis tasks, and start thinking about where you would like to go/research.
- Read over the practice tasks and completed examples to see
 what is required of you to pass. You could read over the article
 too, to give you an idea of how to fill your booklet in using a
 source.
- Next, choose a destination and start searching for possible articles, web sites, blogs, vlogs, travel brochures etc, that give information on that destination.
- THE MAIN TASK IN GLOBETROTTER IS TO COMPARE TWO SOURCES OF INFORMATION AND WRITE DOWN, IN THE BOOKLET, WHICH IS BETTER AND WHY SUCH AS: CLEARER LAYOUT, PERSUASIVE WORD CHOICE, REPETITION IN SENTENCE STRUCTURE (All the things mentioned in pages 1-6 of the booklet).
- Finally, complete the booklet for your destination, reminding yourself how to using the completed examples and practice tasks.
- Then you can be preparing a talk on the sources (see the booklet) then make your own source. You can create a: leaflet, brochure, blog, vlog, website... But you must use the techniques you learned about e.g. persuasive language, facts to support your points, a clear layout, visuals...
