<u>S2 – Creating your own drama.</u>

Look at the picture below. Imagine, this was the Billboard outside the theatre. Use this picture as a stimulus to create your own drama. For example, if you saw this outside a theatre, what would you first impressions of the drama be?

Use your imagination and creativity skills to complete the tasks below.



Task 1: Mind- Map ideas for your drama. You should think about your 5 Ws – Who, What, Where, When, Why.

Who – There should be at least 3 characters in your drama

What – What happens in the beginning, middle and end? Remember the middle should be the climax, the most exciting part of the drama.

Where – Where is the location of your drama?

When - What era is it set in? Example: Present day, 1950s

Why – What is the purpose of your drama? For example, to entertain, to educate an audience about a topic.

Task 2: Write a script for your drama. Remember to include the lines the actors are saying and any stage directions such as the location of the scene.

Task 3: Draw a costume design for each of the characters in your drama.

Task 4: Complete a set design for the key scene in your drama. This should be for the most important scene in your opinion.

Task 5: Imagine you are the director. Write a letter to a theatre company telling them about your new drama and why they should show it at their theatre?
