## Task - Poor Kids Report

While the documentary is still fresh in your memory, you can use it to write a report on the documentary about child poverty in the UK.

## How to tackle the report:

(Use all your notes from the documentary, your own research and the true/false sheet provided at the start. Use the **facts** you copied down from the documentary too.)

The introductory paragraph should include a general description of what child poverty is (a definition) and some facts about the documentary\*. You could also comment that many people probably do not realise just how bad child poverty is in Britain.

**Second paragraph** should introduce the children who were the main focus of the documentary and mention where they live and any family details.

Then, **take a new paragraph for each child** and explain their main problems. Write down as much of the content as you can remember: include what you saw on film, what happened, what they said and what we learned.
