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Dear P7 Pupils and Parents/Carers,

My name is Miss Watson and I am the Depute Head Teacher in charge of P7>S1 transition along with Mrs Connell (House Head) and Ms Taylor (Head of Support for Learning). This is the first of a series of communications I will be sending out to you to introduce you to the staff at Leith Academy and to explain how our school is organised.

You will no doubt be disappointed, as we are, that transition this session will need to be different due to Covid-19. However, we and all the primary staff are looking at how we can creatively still link with you and prepare you for your move into secondary school and support you to become superb S1 Leith Academy pupils.

Throughout this year we have been talking with your P7 teachers and gathering information about you as a person and as a learner. This helps us to create your new S1 classes. We try to make sure you are in the same House Group as any brothers or sisters that are already attending Leith Academy. We balance each class in terms of the number of pupils; gender and practical sets.
