Spanish Speaking countries



In which countries Spanish is spoken?

- More than 350.000.000 people speak Spanish in the world. It is spoken in Spain and also:
- In most of the Latin American countries
 - Mexico Cuba Dominican Republic
 - Puerto Rico Guatemala Honduras
 - Nicaragua El Salvador Costa Rica
 - Panama Ecuador Venezuela
 - Colombia Peru Bolivia
 - Paraguay Uruguay Argentina
 - Chile
- In many places in the United States
- In the Philippines
- In Equatorial Guinea
- And also between the Sephardic Jewish (they lived in Spain for several centuries until they were expelled from the country in 1492 by the Catholic Monarchs, Ferdinand and Isabella).

The 4 languages

- The Spanish/Castellano is the official language in Spain but there are another 3 languages spoken in Spain:
- Euskera, spoken in the Basque Country.
- Catalan, spoken in Cataluña. A very similar dialect is spoken in Valencia and the Balearic Islands.
- Gallego, spoken in Galicia.
