Find a quote from an actor, director or playwright. Write 3 sentences describing why you relate to the quote	Write a short sketch that involves at least one character going through a comical situation	Choose a famous musical, design a new poster and tickets	Write a speech about why drama is important in the world. Deliver the speech to those you live with. Get a written or verbal review. Remember to use persuasive language!
Draw and label an iconic scene from a movie - include the set, props, costume and characters as well as a brief synopsis of what is happening	Choose a favourite speech from a film or TV show. Learn it and perform it to those you live with. Get a written or verbal review	Choose a fairytale and write a bonus scene -this can come at the beginning or end of the traditional story	Write a review of the best film/box set you have seen recently. Include 5ws, your favourite character and favourite scene - give it a rating/5*
Pick your 3 favourite celebrities (real or characters) and write the script for a murder mystery drama	Think of a product that hasn't been invented yet. Design a poster for the product and write a radio advert. You may also want to create a slogan or a jingle. You should include what the item does and the price of the item.	Write a short scene where two characters are having an argument. Include why they fell out and what the resolution to the problem is	Create a pitch for a new Netflix series. Include the 5 Ws, and a synopsis of what happens in each scene. You must have at least 3 episodes. Name the series and decide how long each episode will be
Research a Shakespeare play. Relate the themes/issues to a modern song, film or TV show. Write 50 words explaining your choice	Create a new super villain - design their costume, hair and make up. Write 100 words describing why they are a super villain, their name, and powers, as well as anything else you want to include	Watch a movie or TV show with you family. Interview them afterwards. Find out what they liked/didn't like. Write down their answers in a final review. 100 words	Create and name your own news channel. Your stories can be inspired by true events or you can make up your own. Write a news bulletin. This can be 'breaking news', 'sport', 'weather', 'entertainment' etc.
