Artemis Fowl is not your 'normal' criminal mastermind especially since he is only 12 years old.

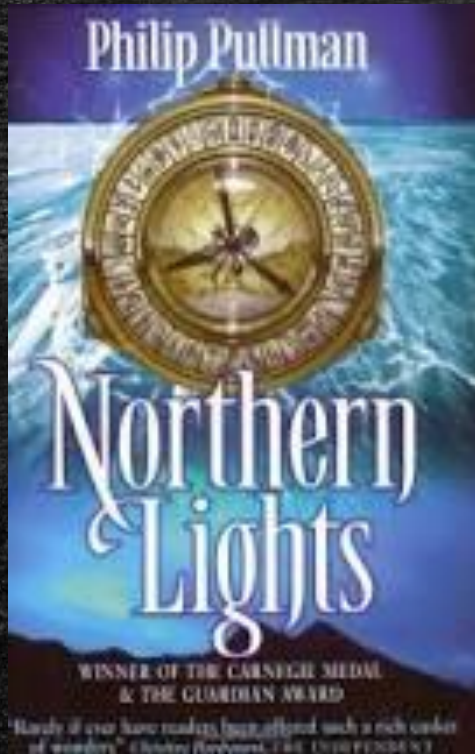

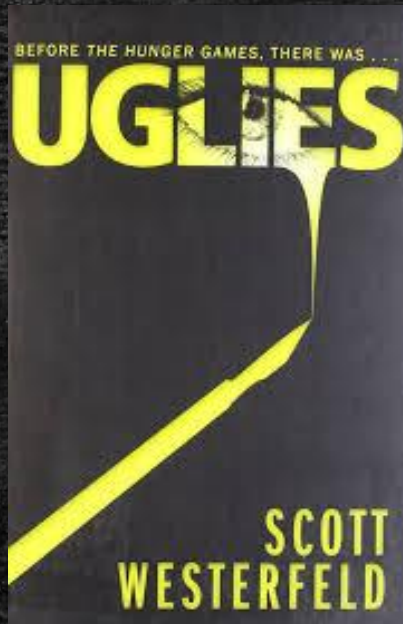

Gone by Michael Grant



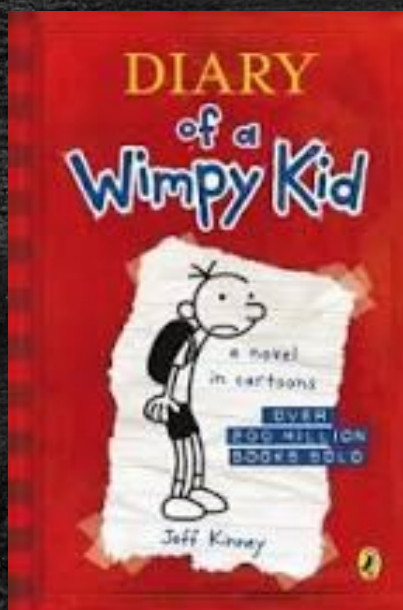

Diary of a Wimpy Kid by Jeff Kinney



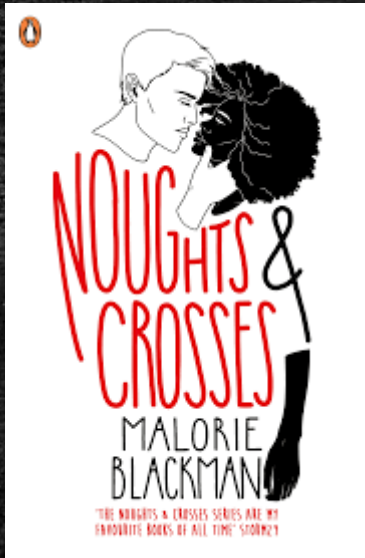

Can their relationship survive the discrimination, and hatred, they encounter at every turn?

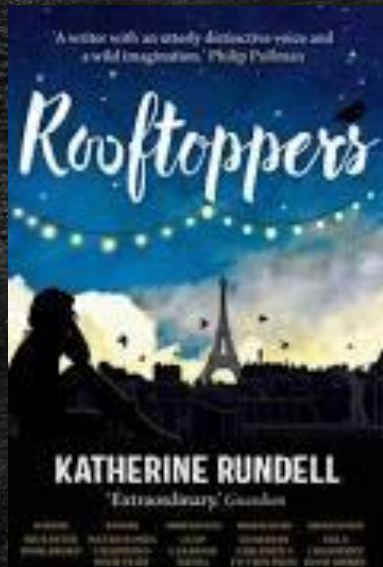

Rooftoppers by Katherine Rundell



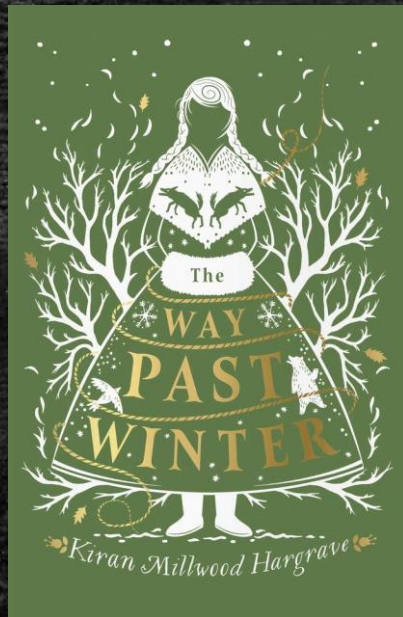

The Way Past Winter by Kiran Millwood Hargrave



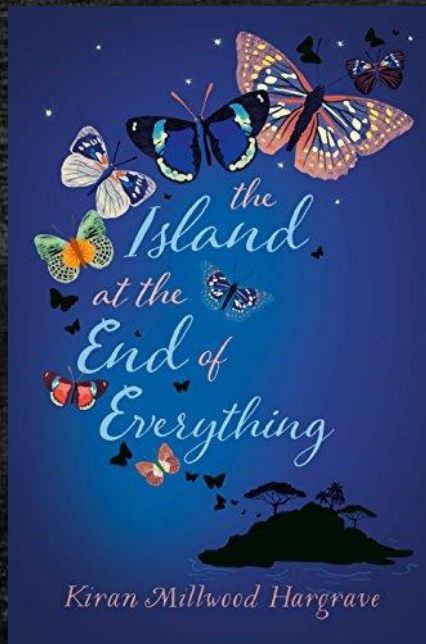

Stella is determined to fight back and enlists the help of her friend Soot, the Hall's friendly chimney sweep ghost.

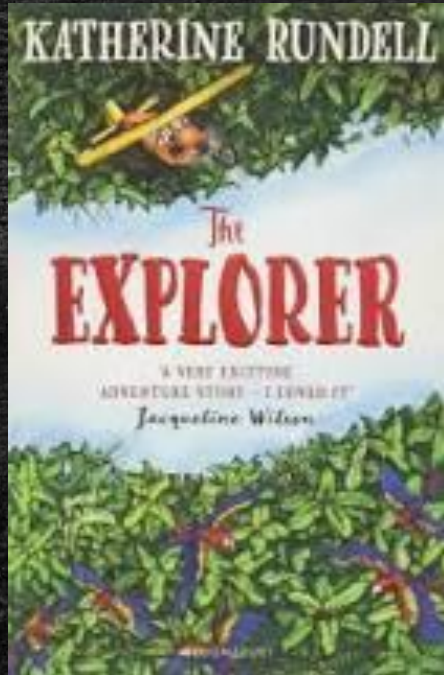

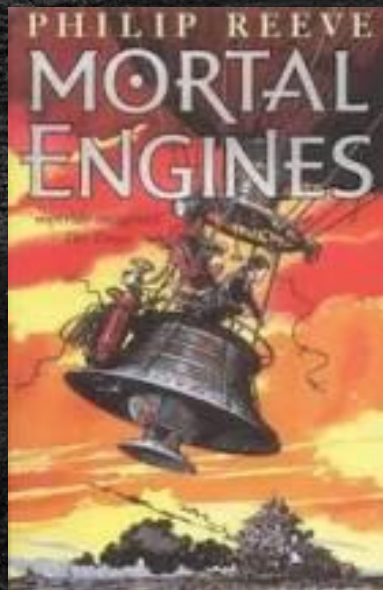

Tom Natsworthy is an apprentice historian from London - but not London as we know it.

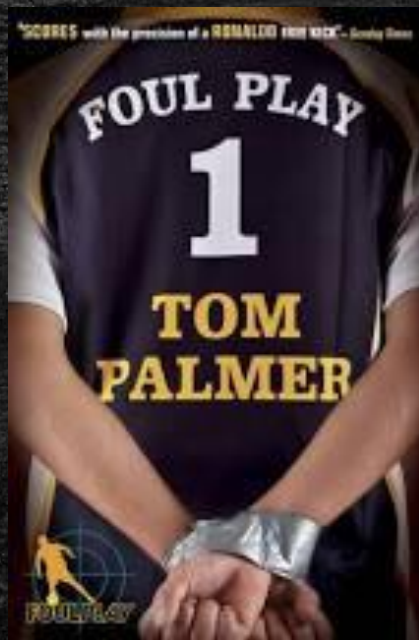
