Employer Insight

Last month some of our S4, S5, and S6 students attended the STEM employer insight session with Optos and Good Loop. Students heard from a Mathematician/Entrepreneur, a Software Engineer, and a Design Engineer. Edinburgh College has twice yearly start dates - in January and August. However, there are limited courses available in January, we usually see a much larger range in August. The January courses have now opened for applications. These are full-time courses and therefore would only be open to those who are old enough to leave school. You can explore the courses here. If you are applying to university this year, you should consider applying to a relevant HNC/D course at college too. A HNC, for some courses at some universities, can allow you to progress to Year 1 and, sometimes, even Year 2. Whereas a HND again, for some courses at some universities, can allow you to progress to Year 1, Year 2, and Year 3.

University

If you are applying to university this year, you should now be making a start on your application. You should also:

- Make sure you are part of the Teams Group UCAS 2022 23 (speak to your House Head if you are not).
- Access 'A Beginners Guide to UCAS 2023' PDF from the Teams page to help get your application started.

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships can be a fantastic opportunity when you leave school to:

- work full time gaining real life work experience whilst gaining key skills and expanding your networks
- gain a qualification (even up to a university degree for some types of apprenticeships)
- and earn a salary.
