## Key Dates:

- **30**<sup>th</sup> June submit SAAS application (you can still apply for SAAS after this date but, if you submit by this date, SAAS will aim to have funding is in place by the start of your course).
- 5<sup>th</sup> July UCAS clearing opens (and will remain open until 17<sup>th</sup> October).
- 8<sup>th</sup> August SQA results day.
- August (date tbc) <u>SDS Exam Results Helpline</u> opens.
- 16<sup>th</sup> October UCAS deadline for any courses at Oxford and Cambridge, and most courses in medicine, veterinary medicine, and dentistry (2024 entry).

### SAAS

Most students who are applying for HNC, HND, or degrees should apply to SAAS for their tuition fees and some students may want to consider applying for a student loan. You should submit your SAAS application by the **30<sup>th</sup> of June 2023** as, if you do, SAAS will aim to process your application before the start of your course. If you apply after this date, they cannot guarantee that they will process your application before the start of your course (however they will backdate any payments to when your course started).

SAAS are still holding free online workshops to support with fees and funding applications however, there are now limited dates left – check availability and book <u>here</u>.

If you have already submitted your SAAS application, you can keep track of the processing times <u>here</u>.

### University

If you submitted your UCAS application on or before the 25<sup>th</sup> of January 2023, you should have received all your decisions from your UCAS choices. Therefore, for most of you, your **deadline to respond is 8<sup>th</sup> of June**. However, if you submitted your application after the 25<sup>th</sup> of you have used UCAS Extra, your deadline may be different. You can find out more <u>here</u>.

**UCAS Extra** - Extra is another chance for you to gain a place at university or college, between 23 February and 4 July. If you used all five of your choices on your original application and you're not holding an offer, you'll be able to add another choice using Extra.

**UCAS Clearing** - Clearing is how universities fill any places they still have on their courses. From 5<sup>th</sup> of July to 17<sup>th</sup> October, you can apply for a course using Clearing if you are not already holding any offers.

# College

Full-Time College Courses starting in August are filling up fast; some courses have already closed but there are still some places available on others. If you have a place at college, you should keep an eye on your emails as you will:

- Receive an email for fees & funding (you may need to complete an application which is linked in the email)
- Receive your course start date and timetable
- Receive a link to enrol for your course online (which you need to do before your course starts).

## Apprenticeships

If you are thinking about leaving school in summer, apprenticeships are a fantastic alternative to college and university. Apprenticeships give you the chance to 'earn whilst you learn'. Check out <u>apprenticeships.scot</u> to find out more.

Please note, apprenticeships are competitive – unlike college or university who will have multiple places on their courses, most employers will usually only recruit one apprentice at a time (however, some larger companies will take on a group of apprentices each year). Some examples of apprenticeships currently recruiting are:
